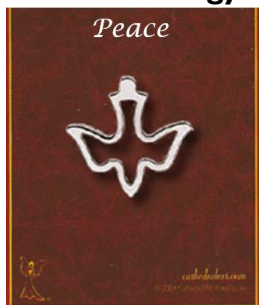
Year 11 Leavers Liturgy
